Over 400,000 Americans wake up each morning with the unpredictability of multiple sclerosis. This disease brings uncertainty to those living with it and stops people from moving. The National MS Society is here to make sure it doesn't. Together, we can turn the uncertainty into hope.

On April 16, the National MS Society is hosting its annual Walk MS here in Charlotte. Registration is free (with fundraising for the walk encouraged) and begins at 9:00 a.m. at Symphony Park in Southpark. Step out against a chronic illness affecting 400,000 Americans -- 8,000 of whom live in the Carolinas. Walk 2-4 miles to raise money and awareness to help people with multiple sclerosis (MS), an unpredictable disease affecting the nervous system for which there is no cure. Strollers and leashed pets welcome. Last year's event drew 1,500 participants and raised \$205,000.
